TURNBERRY, SCOTLAND – June 24, 2016: Donald J. Trump officially reopened Trump Turnberry, a Luxury Collection Resort, at today's Grand Opening Ceremony, attended by his family and VIP guests.

Set along a richly historic landscape and coupled with the incredible renovation of Turnberry's legendary Ailsa Championship golf course, the resort now takes its position as one of the most opulent luxury retreats in the world. This £200 million renovation involves every facet of the 800 acre property, from the magnificent remodeling of all guest rooms and suites to the new state-of-the-art grand ballroom, world-class restaurants, the restoration of the iconic Turnberry Lighthouse, the Golf Academy at Trump Turnberry and much more. The grand re-opening of Trump Turnberry marks a new chapter in the hotel's illustrious 110 year history, which has hosted four of the most exciting championships in all of golf, housed some of the most influential people in modern history, served as the Royal Air Force in the United Kingdom through two World Wars and was the birthplace of Robert the Bruce, King and Founder of Scotland, in 1307.

Turnberry, located along the majestic Ayrshire coastline, consists of 103 state-of-the-art guest rooms, including four magnificent suites (named after Tom Watson, Nick Price, Stewart Cink and Greg Norman, past winners of the prestigious Open Championships hosted at Turnberry). Additionally, included in this iconic renovation is the Grand Tea Lounge & Bar, the world-class Duel in the Sun and 1906 restaurants, as well as the creation of the Donald J. Trump Ballroom, a 500 person grand ballroom set to open in August 2016, which will be the most luxurious meeting facility anywhere in Europe.

Adding to this substantial list of enhancements is the full restoration of the historic Turnberry Lighthouse, which for over a century has acted as an iconic image of Scotland and beautiful Scottish golf. The Turnberry Lighthouse has been transformed into the finest halfway house in the world, creating an experience that is truly unrivaled. Additionally, the lighthouse will offer the United Kingdom's most spectacular two-bedroom presidential suite, which will be priced starting from £3,500 per night. Elegant in its décor and grand in its aura, the Turnberry Lighthouse, overlooking the Firth of Clyde, offers breathtaking views across the Irish Sea, the Isle of Arran, the famous Ailsa Craig and beyond.

A range of experiences are available for guests, including exhilarating outdoor pursuits within the onsite Turnberry Adventures facility and The Spa at Turnberry. The resort is a convenient 25 miles (20 minutes) from Glasgow Prestwick Airport, 55 miles (one hour) from Glasgow Airport and 100 miles (one hour and thirty minutes) from Edinburgh Airport.

Overnight accommodation rates for the hotel start from £389, including breakfast, and from £3,500 per night for The Lighthouse Suite.
